



VOTING DEADLINES

Election Day: November 3, 2020

Last day to register to vote: Postmarked by Oct. 6, 2020 (register by mail), October 6, 2020 (register in-person), October 29, 2020 (register online). In-person, same day registration is also available during early voting and on Election Day. To register in person, you must bring a valid Nevada driver's license or ID with proof of residency.

Must vote in person if you register: October 16-29.

Last day to request a replacement mail-in ballot for ballots that have been lost or damaged:

October 27, 2020

Last day to turn in vote by mail ballot: Must be postmarked or dropped off on November 3, 2020 by 7pm.

How do you register to vote or check your registration status?

- → Online at RegistertovoteNV.gov
- → At your county's supervisor of elections office
- → By mailing in a completed voter registration application

VOTING BY MAIL

- → Voting by mail, voting absentee, voting from home, all mean the same thing: your ballot will be mailed directly to you. It is your right.
- → Voting by mail is safe and secure.
- → All active, registered Nevada voters will automatically receive a vote-by-mail ballot.
- → Once you receive a mailed ballot, return it as soon as you can!

IN-PERSON VOTING

- → If you vote on Election Day, November 3,
 2020, plan to vote at your polling location
 between 7 am and 7 pm
- → If you plan to register to vote during early voting or on Election Day, you must bring a valid Nevada driver's license or ID with proof of residency.
- → Be sure to bring your mask when you vote.
