

CURED BALLOTS IN THE NEVADA 2026 PRIMARY

Signature challenges and cure outcomes in the 2026 primary election

August 2026

Challenge Rates. Overall, Nevada's challenge rate decreased from **3.0%** in the 2022 primary and **2.8%** in the 2024 primary to **1.4%** in the 2026 primary. In Clark County, the challenge rate declined from **3.6%** in 2022 and **3.3%** in 2024 to **0.87%** in 2026. In Washoe County, the challenge rate increased slightly, from **2.0%** in 2022 and **2.3%** in 2024 to **2.7%** in 2026.

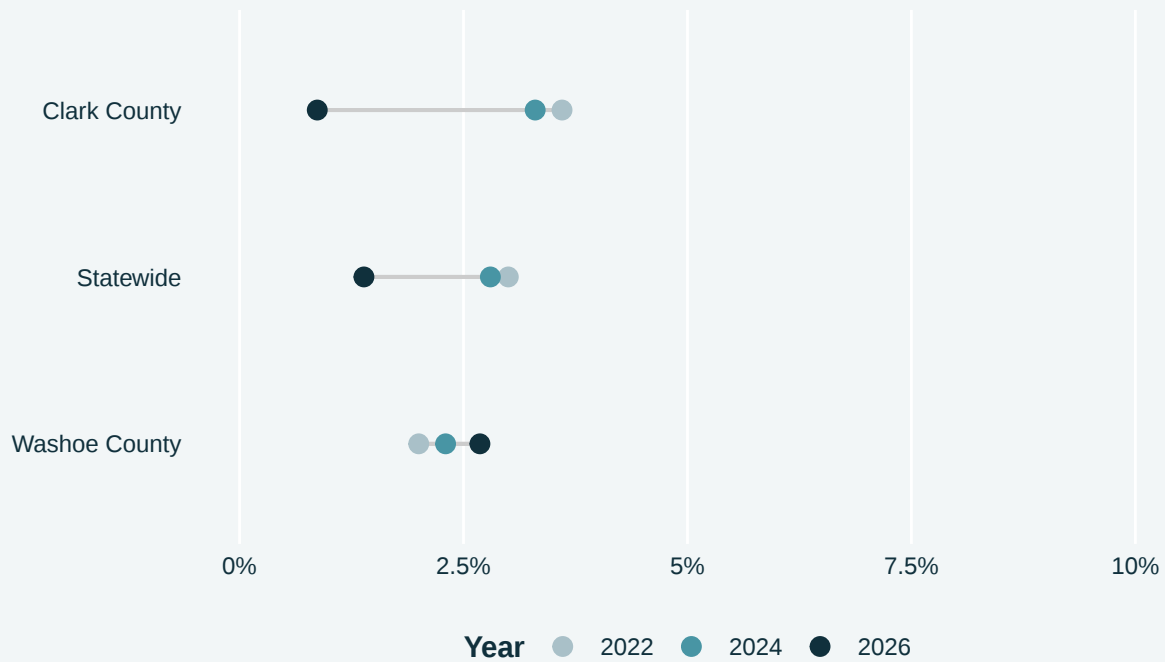
Cure Rates. Statewide, the cure rate increased from **42.5%** in 2022 and **45.9%** in 2024 to **61.5%** in 2026. In Clark County, the cure rate increased from **43.7%** in 2022 and **48.7%** in 2024 to **50.7%** in 2026. In Washoe County, the cure rate rose substantially, from **35.0%** in 2024 to **70.0%** in 2026. Note: data on successfully cured ballots was unavailable for Washoe County for the 2022 primary.

By Age. Across Nevada, voters ages **18–21** experienced the highest challenge rates and the lowest cure rates of any age group.

By Race and Ethnicity. In both Clark and Washoe Counties, **Asian and Pacific Islander (API)** voters had the highest challenge rates, followed by **Hispanic** voters. Statewide and in Washoe County, **White** voters had the highest cure rates. In Clark County, cure rates were more similar across racial and ethnic groups, although API and Native American voters had lower cure rates than other groups.

Percentage of returned mail ballots requiring a signature cure



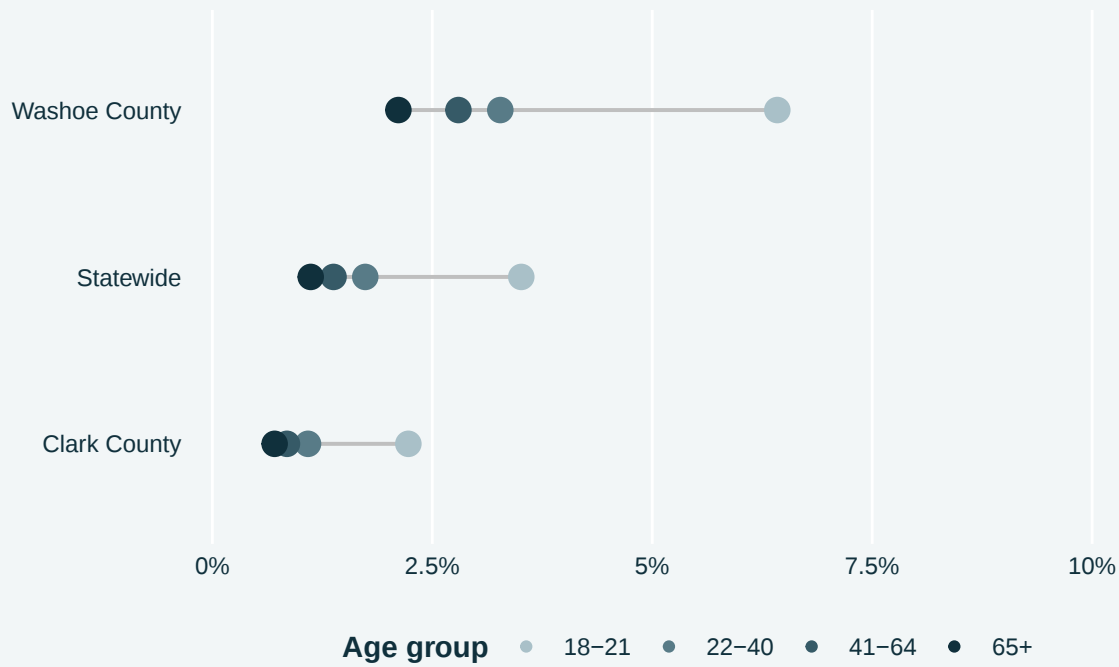
NV Primary 2026 – Cure Rate

Percentage of challenged ballots successfully cured



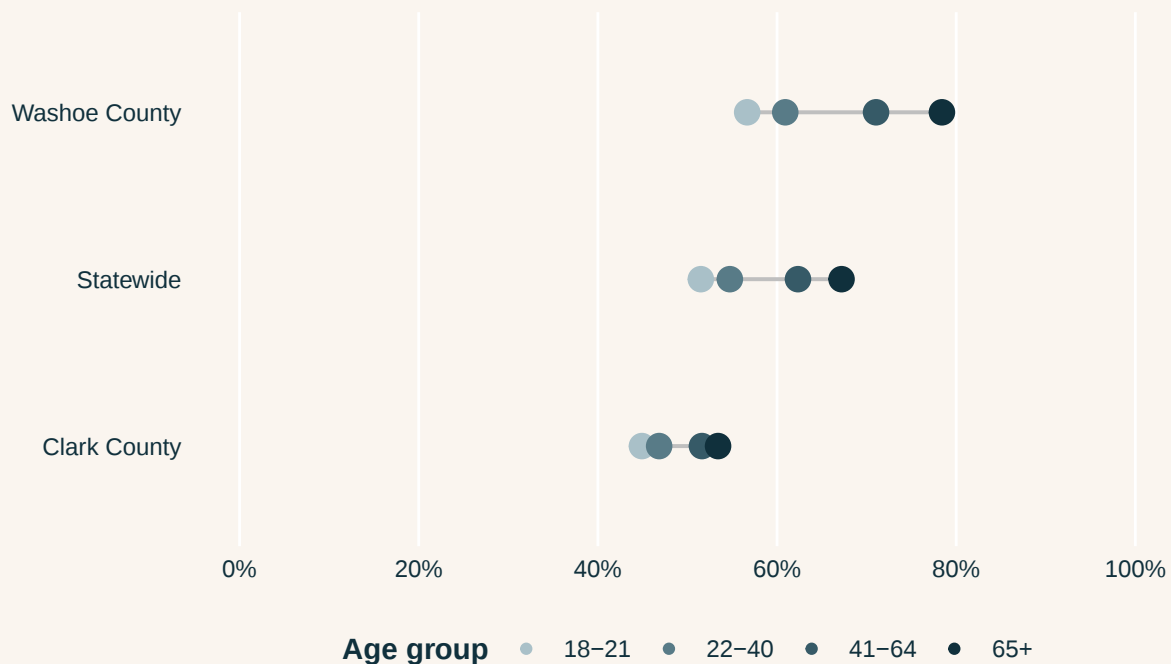
NV Primary 2026 – Challenge Rate by Age Group

Percentage of returned mail ballots requiring a signature cure



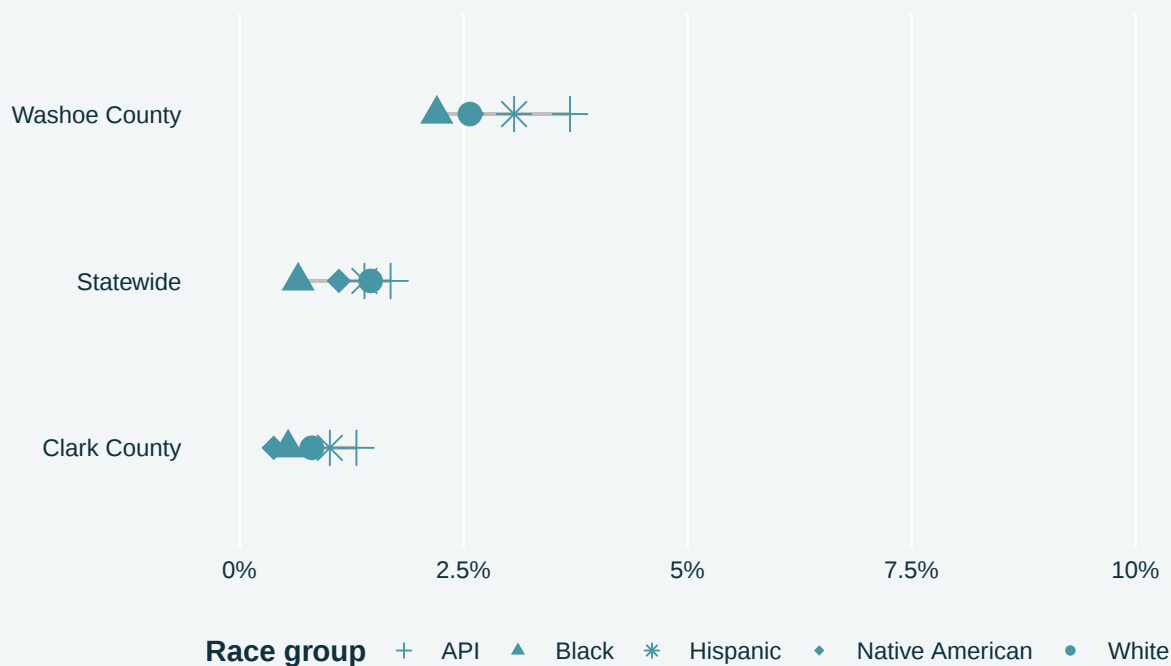
NV Primary 2026 – Cure Rate by Age Group

Percentage of challenged mail ballots successfully cured



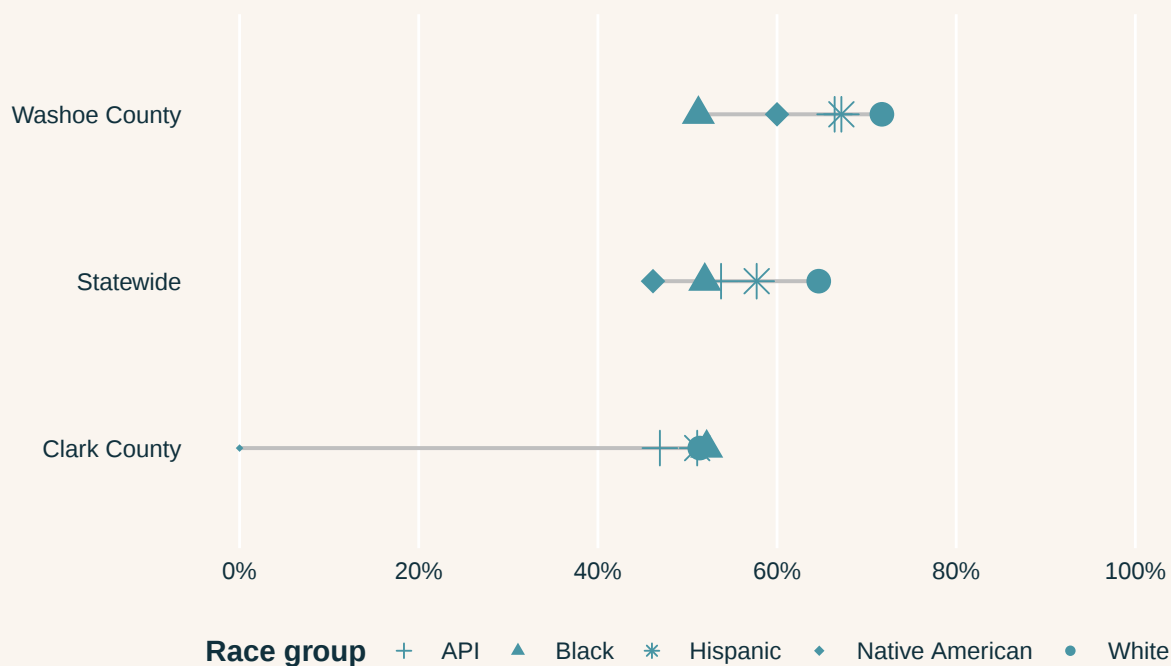
NV Primary 2026 – Challenge Rate by Race
